Phonics/Spelling

Log on to Phonics Play — online phonics games- (Free access using the username march20 and password home).

Play the online game 'Picnic on Pluto'. If not online, write some real and nonsense words on card. Your child needs to read them and then sort them into the 2 group…one for the alien Obb and one for the alien Bob (just like the buried treasure game).

Think about the digraphs: sh, ch, th and ng. Invite the children to go on a digraph hunt, drawing and labelling objects around the house that include those phonemes.

Children count reliably with numbers from one to 20, place them in order and say which number is one more or one less than a given number.

- Ask your child to get a group of objects and say what would be one more
- Practise recognising amounts up to five or up to ten by playing these games.
