

Bearpark Nursery Home Learning Tasks

Spring 2021 - Week 4	Today's task	Adult Input
Monday	Can you watch or read our story of the week? 'The way back home' - YouTube	Ask your child What? Who? Where? How and Why? Questions. Comment on what is happening and ask your child what they think might happen next.
Tuesday	Can you sing along to the song? Using a piece of cloth and a cuddly toy, bounce the toy up and down to count how many bounces until they land on the floor? 'Can you see the bunny bouncing on the grass? Can you see the bunny bouncing on the grass? One and Two and Three and Four, How many bounces till he lands on the floor? 1,2,3,4 etc Tune – 'Sing a song of sixpence'	Repeat the song as many times as you like in different ways! This activity is great for gross and fine motor skills as well as early phonics and maths! Encourage your child to count, using words like more and less. You can use different animals such as a bird flying in the sky or a fish swimming in the sea. Ask your child for their ideas to change the song.



(Repeat the song Loud, quiet, slow and fast)



Wednesday

Can you make a tin foil moon? Wrap tin foil around cardboard, a plate or some paper.


Use bottle lids or coins to make the craters and pens or paint to colour in. You can use anything you have in the house! Talk about shape and size. You can make different sizes and compare, put them in size order.

Ask your child which one is the biggest or smallest?

What does it feel/ look like?


What shapes can you see? Can you find any more circles in your house?

You could even use your creation for small world role play activities.





tionsday	Can you copy the dough disco moves? – YouTube	If you have no access to play dough, you can use a squashy ball or just some tissues. You can find a recipe for homemade play dough on our website under 'home learning Nursery'.
Friday	Can you make a kite and fly it in the wind? Use a piece of paper or a paper bag and attach string to the bottom. You can decorate the paper with whatever you have at home! You could attach different materials to the bottom and watch them blow in the wind. LUNCH SACK	Explore the great outdoors! Encourage your child to discover different textures, sounds, smells and the change in weather. Talk about what is happening to the kite and why Talk about the change in seasons and weather. What happens to the kite if you run fast/ slow?
