Physical Development

This term we will know and talk about the different factors that support their overall health and wellbeing including the following: regular physical activity - healthy eating - tooth brushing - sensible amounts of 'screen time' - having a good sleep routine - being a safe pedestrian. We will continue to develop the skills your child needs to manage the school day successfully: lining up and queuing - mealtimes - personal hygiene Further develop and refine a range of ball skills including: throwing, catching, kicking, passing, batting, and aiming.

We will be focusing this term on children seeing themselves as an individual.
We will be focusing on children learning to manage their own needs.

Literacy

Children will begin their phonics journey exploring oral blending and segmenting, rhyme and alliteration.

We will be learning to read individual letters by saying the sounds for them. We will also read some letter groups that each represent one sound and say sounds for them.

Maths

In Maths we will be learning the following skills. We follow the White Rose scheme of learning.

We will learn to count objects, actions and sounds. We will be learning the skill to Subitise numbers. We will also continue, copy and create repeating patterns.

Understanding the World

Through our topic this half term, me and my home, we will be talking about members of our immediate family and community.

We will also be naming and describing people who are familiar to us.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be learning to listen with increased attention to sounds. We will respond to what we have heard, expressing our thoughts and feelings. We will be learning to remember and sing entire songs. We will sing using the pitch of a tone sung by another person ('pitch match').
