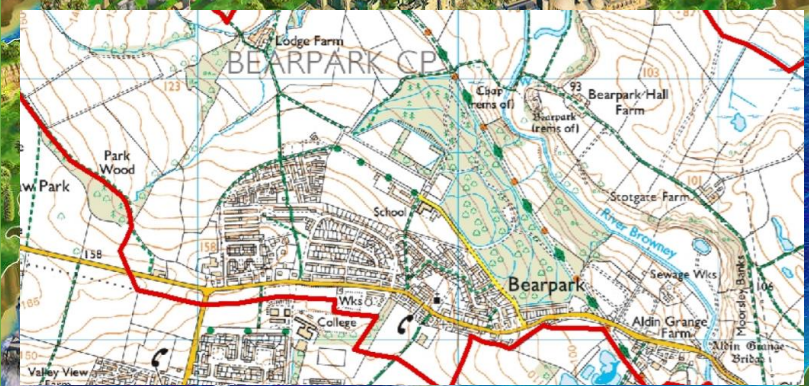

Maths

Daily Early Maths – helps to consolidate prior learning, develop quick recall, build new skills and a love of maths!
Number – place value
Calculation – adding and subtracting
Calculation – multiplying and dividing
We focus on developing reasoning and problem-solving skills across all strands of maths.

Computing

We will be learning about internet safety.
We will be selecting and using software to present data and information.
Children will learn to use technology safely, purposefully and respectfully.

History

What is the history of Bearpark? How has Bearpark changed over the years?
What is the importance of Beaurepaire?
Children will be developing skills in: using historical terms; asking questions about change, similarity and difference and significance; using relevant historical information to construct informed responses.

Music

In Music we will be developing our skills through Samba, using percussion instruments.

Science

We will observe seasonal changes.
We will be learning about animals, including humans.
We will also develop our knowledge of plants.
Children will be working scientifically, asking questions, observing, exploring and researching, to find out what animals, including humans, need to be healthy and stay alive. They will complete investigations and report their findings.

Geography

Is the UK the same everywhere?
We will study the UK and our local area answering questions such as:
Where are the hills, mountains and rivers?
What are the major UK landmarks and where will I find them?
What would we see if we sailed around the edge of the UK?
What are the human and physical features of Bearpark?
Children will develop their skills in using and creating maps, compass directions and completing simple fieldwork.

PE

In PE we will be developing skills and knowledge in yoga, invasion games (hockey) and dance.

English

We will be using a range of texts as inspiration for writing, including:
Fiction Texts: The Magic Finger; The Hodgehog; The Dragon Machine; Paperbag Princess; The True Story of the Three Little Pigs
Poetry: Using nature as inspiration.
Non-fiction texts: A range of texts linked to our topic.
We will be planning and writing for a range of purposes and developing our reading skills.

RE

Children will be finding out about Hinduism. They will learn about how Hindus worship.
They will also learn about Christianity and the why Advent is important.

Art/DT

Children will be studying British artists and developing their skills using a range of materials in their sketchbooks.
The children will be designing and making a Christmas stocking.
