Communication and Language

Our learning:

- Listen attentively and respond to what they hear with relevant questions, comments and actions when being read to and during whole class discussions and small group interactions.
- Make comments about what they have heard and ask questions to clarify their understanding.
- Participate in small group, class and one-to-one discussions, offering their own ideas, using recently introduced vocabulary.



Physical Development

Our learning:

- Negotiate space and obstacles safely, with consideration for themselves and others
- Move energetically, such as running, jumping, dancing, hopping, skipping and climbing
- Use a range of small tools, including scissors, paintbrushes and cutlery

- Understand some important processes and changes in the natural world around them, including the seasons and changing states of matter.

- Talk about the life cycle of a caterpillar, can you draw the stages in order?
- Make a lighthouse using natural materials, using a selection of junk model boxes
- Plant a bean in a plastic cup and watch it grow!
- Plant a sunflower seed at home, take care of it and measure how tall it gets!
- Make a picnic for your family
- Write a shopping list to help your adults at home!
- Practise counting up to 20!
- Find ways of making number bonds within 10
- Draw/paint a picture of a sunflower
- Talk about healthy and unhealthy lunches you could have and draw your favourite lunch
- Draw a character or scene from the story and write words to describe
